Electronics Recycling

Pursuant to the New York State Electronic Equipment Recycling and Reuse Act, as of January 1, 2015 residents may no longer dispose of electronics in landfills, in the trash or at the curb for trash pick-up.

City of Albany residents have the following options to recycle their unwanted electronics

- Electronics can be dropped off at the Department of General Services located at 1 Richard J Conners Blvd, Albany, NY 12204, Monday – Friday 7 AM – 5 PM. Residents must check in with the front office staff to show proof of residency and then they will be directed to the drop-off area.
- 2. Electronics are accepted at the City of Albany's annual Household Hazardous Waste and Electronic Drop-off Events. Pre-registration is required to attend these events as there are limited appointments available. For a full listing of available dates and to pre-register, please visit www.albanyrecycles.com
- 3. Electronics may be returned to NYS Electronic Waste Collection Sites such as Best Buy and Staples. Please note: Not all sites accept all types of electronics and there may be a fee associated with the dropoff.
