

## **HOLIDAY RECYCLING GUIDE**



Recycle CLEAN aluminum foil roasting pans and pie tins.



Compost Holiday meal food scraps in your backyard composter or bring to a drop-off location.



Avoid single use plates, napkins and cutlery.



Real Christmas trees & wreaths
CAN be composted.
Remove decorations, tinsel,
lights and metal wire ties, etc.



Wrapping paper & Christmas cards containing glitter, tinsel or metallic coatings CANNOT be placed in the recycling bin. Plain wrapping paper & Holiday cards CAN be recycled.

Boxes & grey board CAN be recycled but tissue paper CANNOT.

Avoid single use plastic dreidels.

Cellophane, ribbons & bows CANNOT be recycled. Please place these items in your regular trash.



Use re-usable stemware and cups over single use plastic ones.



Use digital invitations instead of paper.



Use decorations that say "Happy New Year" without a specific year so you can reuse again.
