As in years past, City of Albany residents will have multiple chances to dispose of their household hazardous and electronic waste in an environmentally safe way. Residents must pre-register to participate. **Please note: phone registration is closed the Friday before each event and online registration is closed the Tuesday before each event.** However, registration for an event could close earlier if the maximum capacity is reached. Successful collection efforts have helped to protect our groundwater from hazardous waste contamination.
